1	Female Sheep	Female sheep (Ewe), adaptable to the environment of the Yakawlang district of Bamyan province. Pregnant (six months or more) or with newborn lambs (one to three months old). Ewe must be young, free of diseases, physically fit, and between 2 to 3 years of age. The weight of the sheep should not be less than 35kg To ensure adaptability and avoid mortality during transportation the procurement must be done in Bamiyan province. Important points about animals:

- 1. Time for arranging the animals: After awarding the contract the supplier must complete all the distribution within 20 days.
- 2. Time of Quarantine: After arrival at the warehouse there should be at least 5 days of quarantine to inspect the female sheep and the supplier should provide all the services (Feeding, Water, etc.)
- 3. Feeding for the time of Quarantine? Suppliers must provide feeding during the quarantine time to keep female sheep healthy.
- 4. vaccines enterotoxemia (2 CC to each Ewe) must be administered to all Ewes during the quarantine period in front of IRW staff and DAIL representative, before distribution to rightsholders.
- 5. Inspection time: Whenever a supplier provides more than 100 female sheep the inspection will take place and the supplier should immediately remove rejected female sheep from inside the warehouse.
- 6. Location of inspection: The inspection location must be inside Bamiyan province.

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- 7. Arrangements are needed in place for handling live animals: A proper warehouse with all the essential requirements should be in place like (good condition rooms, feeding/water system)
- 8. Transportation mechanism: Normal transportation (in large trucks) from stock to distribution point.
- 9. The supplier must get the female sheep to the distribution point (1) hour before distribution time and must be take care of the animals until distribution is finished in case any animal is missing during the distribution vendor is responsible for the death or injury animals in such cases vendor is responsible for replacement.

The Supplier must be registered as a livestock supplier or Agriculture Services provider with relevant government authorities and must have a valid Business license.

- 1- Quoted prices for the above items shall be inclusive of all kinds of govt. taxes and duties as per prevailing Tax Laws of Govt. of Afghanistan, Transportation, Distribution, loading unloading, and customs clearance (if any)
- 2- All prices must be quoted in Afghani (AFN), quotations in other currencies will not be accepted.
- 3- Prices quoted shall be Delivered Duty Paid (DDP) at the identified locations.
- 4- Any damage, loss, theft, and demurrages outside the premises of Islamic Relief (Afghanistan) shall be the responsibility of the supplier/agent.
- 5- Withholding tax as per government prevailing rates shall be deducted at the time of

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payment.

- 6- Payment shall be made in the form of **Bank Transfer** within 21 working days after acceptance of delivery and subsequent acceptance of the invoice to the Islamic Relief (Afghanistan).
- 7- Islamic Relief shall have the right to award the contract as a whole or in lots to one supplier or more.
