Specific Objective: a) Conduct offline or online training of project staff on specific interventions in a project to improve Productivity, Well-being and Self-Regulation Skills among Home-Based Learners

b) Provide continued support to project staff to improve the service delivery and address barriers to improve fidelity to the designed intervention.

Background: Children in Crisis(CIC)/Street Child began working in Kabul, Afghanistan, in 1997 and since then has worked consistently within Kabul and across Afghanistan's provinces to improve access to quality education for the most marginalized children, to guarantee that children in conflict with the law have their legal rights protected and afforded to them, to increase the participation of women and girls in all areas of public and private life, and to remove disability as a barrier to inclusion in all areas of child's life.

Project Background: Children in Crisis(CIC)/Street Child, in partnership with National and International Partners, is to provide free and quality education to 770 secondary-aged children who have recently completed Grade 6 in Kabul through an offline-first blended learning approach. This program will establish 22 digital classes (35 children per class) managed by 20 trained teachers using an Android application, ensuring each child is safe, connected, and learning. The program includes three key interventions: 1) "Safe," enhancing teacher and counselor capacities to ensure a secure learning environment and effective safeguarding measures; 2) "Connected," promoting interaction and collaborative learning through online and physical meet-ups, monthly coaching, and internet bundles; and 3) "Learning," increasing access to education through offline video lectures, flexible learning methods, teacher training, and interactive content, supplemented by biweekly assessments and in-person and online support sessions. The program aims to empower marginalized children by providing them with control over their learning path and pace, essential for continued education in challenging contexts.

Rationale: CIC is seeking an external consultant to train and support Staff to Improve Productivity, Wellbeing and Self-Regulation Skills among Home-Based Learners. The risk identified under this project includes home based learners may lack the self-regulation skills needed to manage their studies offered via blended learning. To mitigate the risk following mitigation strategies are proposed to be operationalized:

- 1. Initial orientation and counseling
- 2. Provision of weekly self-learning plans
- 3. Regular check-ins through online discussion board and face to face meetings
- 4. Collaborative learning opportunities
- 5. Teaching strategies to improve productivity and time management
- 6. Online support services
- 7. Regular parental check-ins

Methodology: The training and support can be made available to Street Child through online sessions/in person.

Scope of work: The external consultant will be required to train and support Staff to Improve Productivity, Wellbeing and Self-Regulation Skills among Home-Based Learners. Towards that end, the consultant will be required to undertake the following specific tasks:

- 1. In consultation with CIC project team, the consultant will develop a plan document detailing the strategy to be operationalized to Improve Productivity, Wellbeing and Self-Regulation Skills among Home-Based Learners in the project. Among other things, the document shall detail the tools and templates to be used, scheduled trainings for capacity strengthening, planned check-ins that shall aid in operationalization of the strategy and monitoring the implementation of the strategy.
- 2. Training of project staff to operationalize the strategy
- 3. Monthly periodic check-ins to support project staff improve the service delivery and address barriers to improve fidelity to the designed intervention.

Main deliverables: In accordance with the schedule of activities, the consultant will produce:

- 1. Plan document detailing the strategy to be operationalized to Improve Productivity, Wellbeing and Self-Regulation Skills among Home-Based Learners in the project. Among other things, the document shall detail the tools and templates to be used, scheduled trainings for capacity strengthening, planned check-ins that shall aid in operationalization of the strategy and monitoring the implementation of the strategy.
- 2. PowerPoint Presentation and online training of project staff to operationalize the strategy as detailed in the plan document
- 3. Monthly 1 page report documenting the reflections and suggestions based on the discussions during Monthly periodic check-ins

Duration of the assignment: The consultancy shall be for tenure of 2-3 months and support the project team if need during 5 months . The successful applicant shall be contracted for all further evaluations during the course of the project.

Institutional Arrangements: The consultant will report directly to the Education Project Manager at CIC/Street Child. CIC will provide relevant background documents necessary for the evaluation and shall be responsible for the coordination of meetings and other activities during the evaluation.
