- Record of Financial Turnover for the last 3 years (2022 to 2024) with minimum yearly turnover value of **USD 100,000.00.**

The above required documents should be sent through email to iomkabulprocurement@iom.int and put the RFQ Ref No. **AF10/RFQ/24/0440** in the subject line of the email as of Tuesday **30 July 2024 and latest by 11 August 2024 before 04:30PM.** Only Eligible Companies will receive the complete bidding documents via email.

The schedules and locations of pre-bid meeting and site visit will be shared with the eligible companies, along with the complete bidding documents.

Bids shall be valid for a period of (120) days after submission of bids and shall be delivered to Hawa Shenasi Road, Beside of Kabul International Airport, Baron Compound, Kabul Afghanistan on or before 19 August 2024, at 02:30PM. Late submission of bids will not be accepted.

IOM reserves the right to accept or reject any bids, and to cancel the procurement process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of Contract, without obligation to inform the affected Bidder/s of the ground for IOM action.

IOM tenders are free of any charges. No fees are charged to collect the bidding documents, participate in the pre-bid meeting, and site visit.
