- 10 We confirm that we are not engaged in any corrupt, fraudulent, collusive or coercive practices and acknowledge that if evidence contrary to this exists, **Union Aid** reserves the right to terminate the contract with immediate effect.
- 11 We are not bankrupt or being wound up, are having our affairs administered by the courts, have not entered into an arrangement with creditors, have not suspended business activities, are not the subject of proceedings concerning those matters, or are in any analogous situation arising from a similar procedure provided for in national legislation or regulations
- 12 We must not be engaged in any corrupt, fraudulent, collusive or coercive practices including but not limited to applying/ bidding by multiple names / companies. If we found to be involved in such practices our bid may be rejected and the companies in question permanently black listed.
- 13 We have not been convicted of an offence concerning professional conduct by a judgment which has the force of res judicata
- 14 We have not been guilty of grave professional misconduct proven by any means which the contracting authority can justify
- 15 We have fulfilled obligations relating to the payment of social security contributions or the payment of taxes in accordance with the legal provisions of the country in which we are established or with those of the country of the contracting authority or those of the country where the contract is to be performed
