Project Name: Construction of 100MT Capacity Cold Storage at Ghuryan District in Herat Province includes Architectural, Structural, Mechanical and Electrical Works.

Eligibility for obtaining a complete set of RFP is that interested bidders must provide the following documents:

- The company updates business license issued by ministry of Commerce of the origin country or where the project being implemented.
- Provision of documents demonstrating similar work experience, with a minimum value of \$150,000.00, with UN Agencies or other International Organizations within the last 5 years, specifically in the field of civil construction works, specializing in steel structure construction with electrical and/or mechanical components.

The above required documents should be sent through email to iomkabulprocurement@iom.int and put the RFP Ref No. AF10/RFP/24/0001 in the subject line of the email as of 31 December 2024 and latest by 23 January 2025 before 02:00PM. Only Eligible Companies will receive the complete bidding documents via email.

The schedules and locations of pre-bid meeting and site visit will be shared with the eligible companies, along with the complete bidding documents.

Bids shall be valid for a period of (120) days after submission of bids and shall be delivered to Hawa Shenasi Road, Beside of Kabul International Airport, Baron Compound, Kabul Afghanistan on or before 06 February 2025, at 02.30PM. Late submission of bids will not be accepted.

IOM reserves the right to accept or reject any bids, and to cancel the procurement process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of Contract, without obligation to inform the affected Bidder/s of the ground for IOM action.

IOM tenders are free of any charges. No fees are charged to collect the bidding documents, participate in the pre-bid meeting, and site visit.
